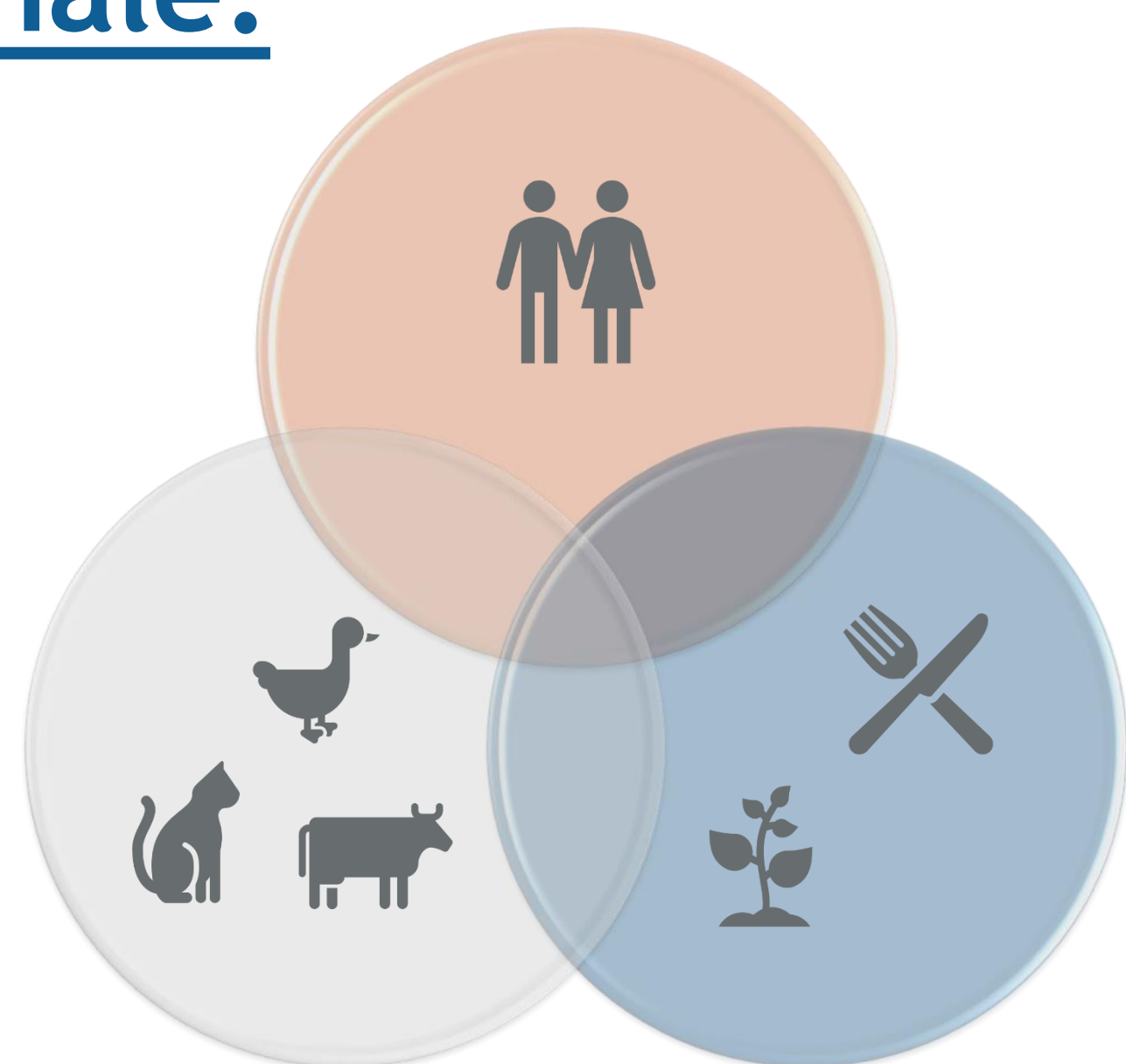

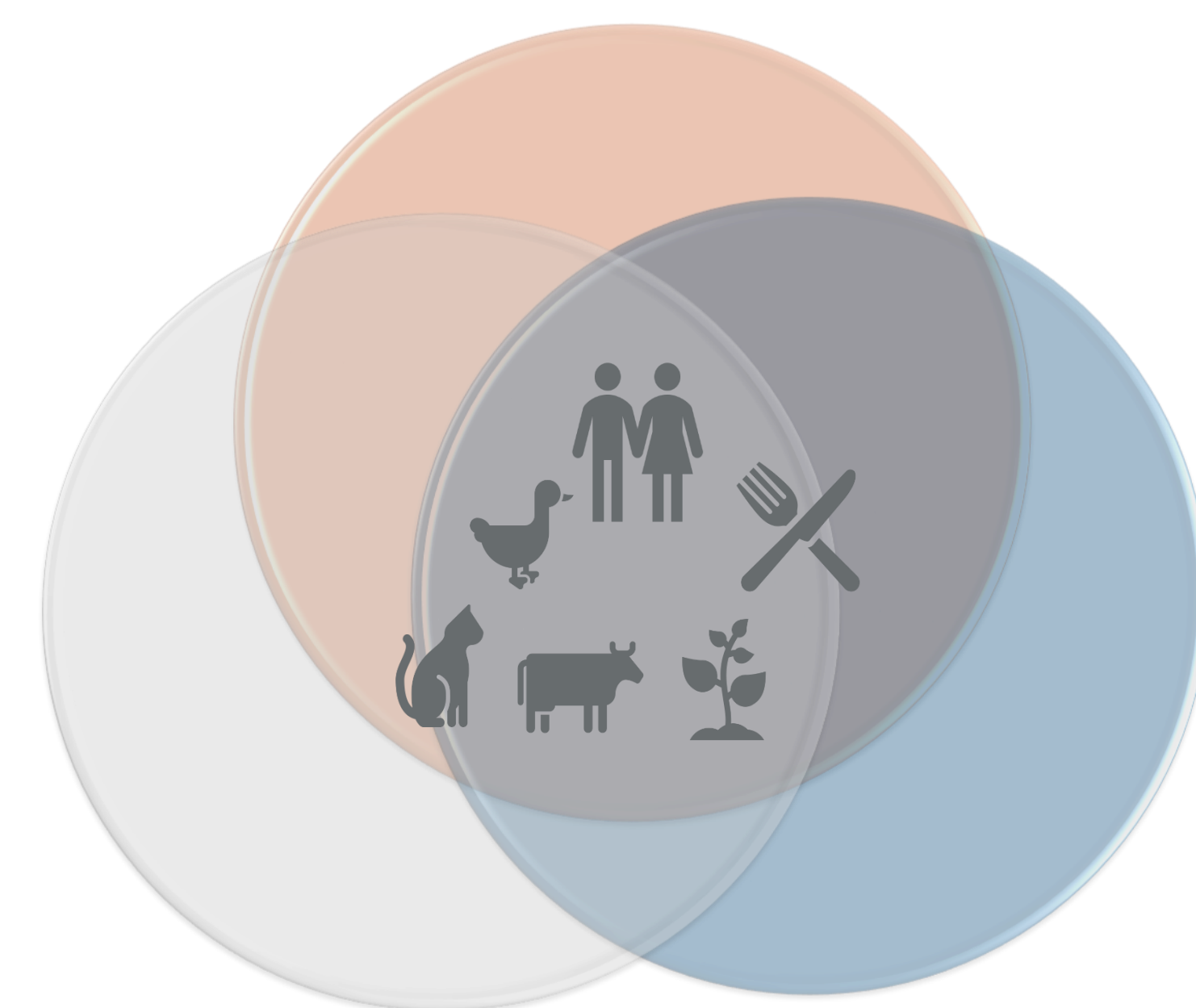

Rationale:



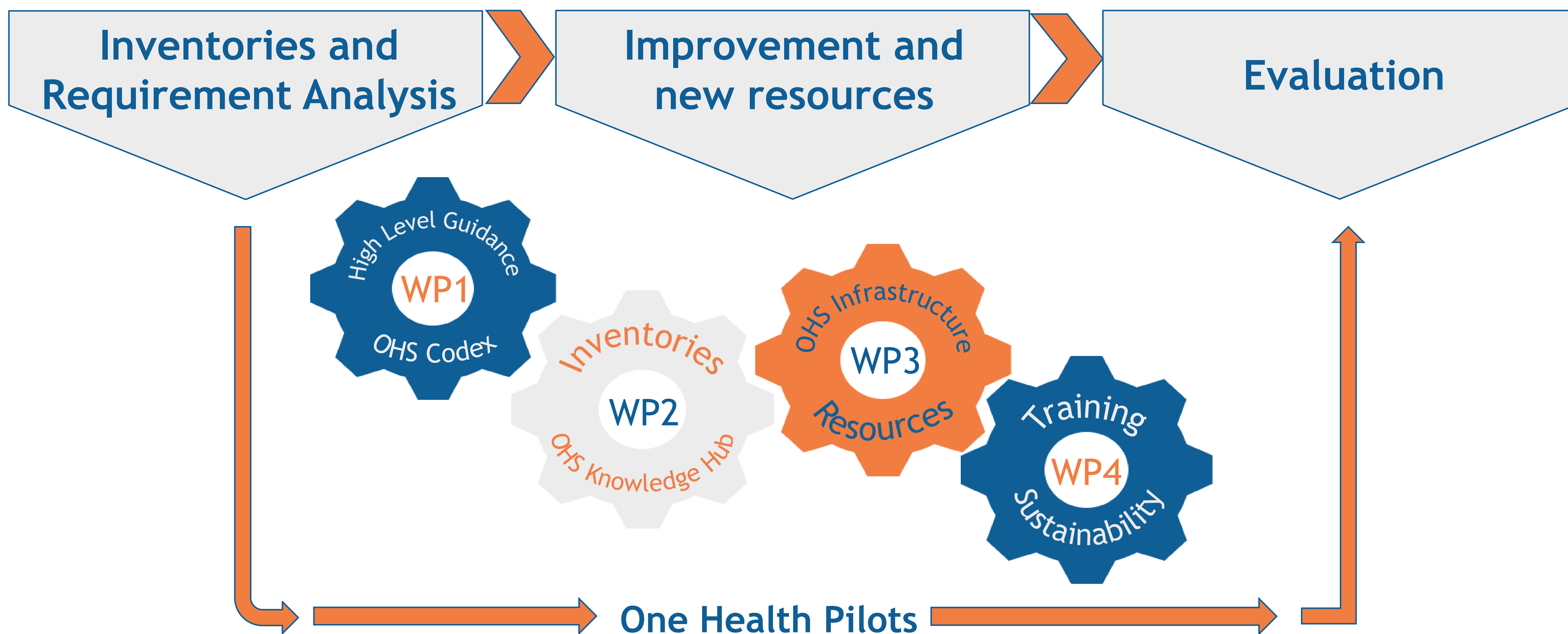
- No true state-of-the-art established yet in One Health Surveillance (OHS)
